 - C. The Conflict.
 - 1. Why does the dragon stand before the woman?
 - a. Did this happen in the Old Testament?
 - b. Can you think of examples?
 - 2. The child is born and caught up to heaven. To what event(s) does this refer?
 - 3. To what does the woman in the wilderness (vs. 6) refer? (Remember what 1,260 days refer to? (11:3)
