A. General:

 - c. That on which she sits.
 - d. Where she is located.

 - a. Some suggest Rome. What are the arguments for and against?
 - b. Some suggest the papacy. What are the arguments for and against?
 - 2. What is the meaning of the following:
 - a. A harlot:
 - 1) The cup in her hand?
 - 2) Mother of harlots and guilty of fornication with the kings and inhabitants?
 - b. Babylon:
 - 1) Of what is the OT Babylon a type?
 - 2) What has Revelation said about "Babylon" thus far? (14:8; 16:10; see also 17:19)
 - c. Sitting on the beast:
 - 1) What is the beast?
 - 2) Sitting on water, mountains, etc.?
 - 3. What then is the meaning and significance of the woman and of this vision?
